TO MAKE JONAH AND THE FISH

The help of an **adult** may be needed when cutting and assembling


Print out the fish (page 1) onto thin card or heavy weight paper. (160 + gsm copy card is suitable)

N.B. The fish can be printed onto **white** card for colouring in **OR** print onto **colored** card (e.g. blue or green) for coloring in using lighter shade colored pencils. If using colored card for the fish you may want to print Jonah (page 2) onto white card





TO MAKE THE FISH: Cut out the fish body, fins and tail






side (back/inside) facing...






2. Open out again then fold both edges into the center along the first/centre fold line.

3. Open out again. With top/printed side facing put glue onto the base triangle marked 'glue' then stick onto the back of the other base triangle (with the text on).



Fold under and stick together to form base



4. Glue on fins and tail where marked.



Cut out the Jonah piece and color in.



Fold in half with the back (plain) sides facing then fold the other way along the dotted lines by Jonah's feet. Add a small spot of glue to the inside of the head and stick together.



Cut out the sign, color in then fold in half



TIP

To make folding easier either score the fold lines first before folding or place a ruler along the fold lines, fold the card up along the ruler edge before folding down.

As some pages have images close to the edge make sure your printer is set to the correct paper size or reduce the image size by a few % or select 'fit to page'.
